

## **The following conditions will be considered for Red Flag events:**

- \* Scattered dry thunderstorms with greater than 15 percent coverage.
- \* Increased thunderstorm activity, wet or dry, during an extremely dry period.
- \* When surface winds are expected to increase to 20 mph or higher or change directions abruptly due to the approach and passage of a cold front, squall line, or other weather phenomena other than isolated thunderstorms.
- \* Relative humidity below 20% with surface wind 20 mph or higher in the summer (June, July, August) with green grass.
- \* Relative humidity below 30% with surface wind 20 mph or higher in the spring before green up (April, May) or in the fall after the grass turns brown (September, October).
- \* Anytime the forecaster foresees a change in weather that would result in a significant increase in fire danger.
